March 10, 2022 Board Meeting



The March meeting was held via Zoom on Thursday, March 10, 2022. The resignations of **Jim Blaine, Burley Mitchell, Stephanie Poston, and Gray Styers** were accepted with regret.

Our current membership is 193 (163 active and 30 senior).

For the fiscal year through February 28, 2022, Treasurer **John Collar** reported operating income of \$29,359.37, operating expenses of \$46,401.52, service income of \$21,600, service expenses of \$2,805.27, net assets of \$93,173.07, and accounts receivable of \$16,181.

The survey results were reviewed with the bottom line of the majority in favor of a dues increase (the first one in 20 years) with a vote from the membership on May 6, 2022. The board approved increasing the Active Member dues from \$115 to \$120/qtr. on October 1, 2022, with further increases of \$5/qtr each October 1 until we reach \$140/qtr.

Charter Night is May 20, 2022 (Friday night) with sign-ups coming in April. We will provide Swift Creek Elementary School with dictionaries for their 3rd and 4th graders. Corporate membership was discussed as a membership option. Further research is needed on implementation. Diaper Train donations will be collected in April.

Buck Lattimore, Leslie Jones, Courtney Allen, KC Ramsay, and Chris White will represent the club at the Mid-Year Conference of the Carolinas District on March 19, 2022.

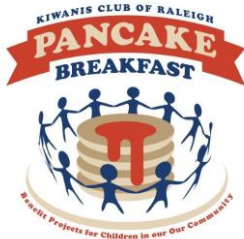
